


LockDown When Using iPads

TEACHER SETTINGS:


Teachers must allow lockdown to be used when using iPads as the assessment tool.

Steps:

1. Open Schoology
2. Go to the course the assessment/test is associated to
3. Click Lockdown from the left navigation area
4. Locate the test you wish assign lockdown to
5. Click the arrow next to the name and choose settings



6. Make sure you choose "Require Respondus LockDown Browser for this exam"
7. Click Advanced Settings
 - Check–Allow Students to take this exam with an iPad





STUDENT SETUP:

Steps:

1. Click the LockDown Browser App
2. Type Oxford School District if you have the following Screen is show and then select the Oxford School District from list.



3. Now that you have entered the district information, LockDown will look like the following:



LockDown Browser shouldn't be used to navigate to an exam. Instead, use a standard browser (eg. Safari, Chrome) to locate your exam. Then the LockDown Browser app will automatically launch if the exam requires it. You may exit the browser now.
